RESOLUTION No. 17-001

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING
REVISION TO THE SOUTHEAST REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP) –
PERFORMANCE MEASURES**

WHEREAS, the Southeast Regional Transportation Planning Organization (SERTPO) is a regional transportation planning organization made up of local, county and tribal governments within the counties of Chaves, Curry, DeBaca, Eddy, Guadalupe (Town of Vaughn), Lea, Lincoln, Otero and Roosevelt Counties;

WHEREAS, the SERTPO participated in long range planning processes with NMDOT during its development of the New Mexico Long Range Multi-Modal Transportation Plan, and, in conjunction with those processes, SERTPO also partnered with NMDOT and participated in the development of the NMDOT Southeast Regional Transportation Plan (RTP);

WHEREAS, the SERTPO met in regular meeting and approved the Southeast RTP in August 2015;

WHEREAS, the Southeast RTP is a living document and a working tool for the SERTPO, and periodic updates may be proposed to update the Plan for improved efficiencies;


WHEREAS, the SERTPO has recognized a need for establishing performance measures and has designated a SERTPO Subcommittee for the purpose of developing and recommending performance measures, in addition to other tasks;

WHEREAS, the SERTPO Subcommittee has proposed recommendations to the SERTPO Policy Committee in the form of an update to the Southeast RTP; and

WHEREAS, the SERTPO has been given review time of the proposed update in advance via their meeting packet, submitted electronically.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SERTPO Policy Board hereby approves a Revision to the Southeast RTP, as considered during its January 2017 meeting, and as may have been amended during the January 2017 meeting.
